

Notary Service Options

Option #1-

Become a notary or have one of your staff members become a notary. You can check with your state to see what is required. The requirements are usually very minimal. This will give you the ability to notarize documents in your own office at no cost to the client.

Option #2-

Schedule a professional mobile notary for your clients to come to their home, office or local coffee shop anywhere in the United States. You can find the link for this service in your back office under the Sales Tab.
